We are praying for every heart and every mile of South Carolina, focusing specifically on those who need a relationship with Jesus Christ. Before you begin, you may ask the question, "What is prayerwalking and how do I do it?"

Here are some thoughts as you prepare your people:

PRAY WITH INSIGHT. | Prayerwalking can be defined as praying on-site with insight. Be aware of where you are praying. What do you see along the journey?

PRAY WITH INTENTION. | October and November, 2009 have been designated as months to intentionally pray for those who need a personal relationship with Christ.

PRAY WITH THE HEART OF AN INTERCESSOR. | An intercessor is someone who "stands in the gap"—a gap between one person and their need for God.

PRAY WITH INFORMATION. | Do you know who lives in your community? How many single parents are there? Be open to learning about the "hidden" needs in your community.

PRAY WITH INSPIRATION. | Prayerwalk with Scripture verses. The way to pray the will of God is to pray the Word of God.
